

## RESULTS FROM FOUNDATION

- Bailey family **clothed, fed, sheltered, and rehabilitated locals** addicted to illegal drugs and alcohol for over 40 years. This Family would help locals addicted to drugs leave that lifestyle and would even give them odd jobs until they were able to find work in regular society. Sometimes they would even accept those seeking help to odd jobs in lieu of paying rent if they were in need of shelter.
- Bailey family allowed Mothers to drop off there kids to their home where they would clean them, feed them, & educated them while giving them HOPE in the **only FULL SERVICE, FREE DAYCARE CENTER**, funded by the Bailey & McDaniel Family! Over 25 years of servicing a Free Day care Center for all in need.
- Individuals that where sick that could not afford health services where allowed to show up at the Bailey's Home, where a **local doctor treated those that where ill**, in exchange for services Elizabeth Bailey McDaniel (mother) rendered to Doctor by Weekly Referrals that could pay.
- Bailey family purchased materials and **built homes and renovated trailers** to house the underprivileged/those coming home from prison, (ALL labor materials to build homes, including food & clothing) without **SPONSORS OR GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE!** Only outside help came from the underprivileged individuals we helped (immediately hired after release from jail) that reaped Benefits.
- Bailey family provided **assistance to people in need when government agencies turned them down through their Political Connect**. The Top officials running for office always begin Running for Office at the Bailey's Home knowing if this family supported them, the entire community would follow! The First Black Political Figure began at this home, now he has a Bridge Named after him... still to this day!
- Bailey family has **opened the doors of their personal home** when someone reached out. Something just as simple as providing a place to lay one's head or a hot meal meant so much to those people in need. That gave them Hope & that Family System provided the opportunity for that Hopeful Change!
- **Spearheaded Voter Registration drives** which inspired adults who had never been involved in the political process to use the voice they never had by voting. This family would provide transportation to and from the polls on election days for those who would otherwise stay home.
- **The Bailey Family learned Entrepreneurship at an early age!** Including:
  1. Two (2) FREE Daycare Centers
  2. Four (4) Trailer Parks  
To house the underprivileged, drug and alcohol addicted as well as the homeless
  3. Small retail store
  4. Transportation Services
  5. Housing Services
  6. Recreation area to take youth off the streets by giving them something To do including a Game Room, Pool Hall & Basketball Court
